Appointments must be pre-paid. Offices open Mon-Fri

Check-in is at 7:00am for dogs, 7:30 for owned cats, and 8:00 am for feral cats.

The cost of spay/neuter surgery varies depending on animal, size and procedure:

Female dog spay 0-50 lbs.	\$145.00	Female cat spay	\$95.00
Female dog spay 51-100 lbs.	\$210.00	Male cat neuter	\$65.00
Female dog spay 101+ lbs.	\$245.00	Feral cat spay or neuter	\$15.00

Fixed Price (No Coupon) Program - SNAP works with several veterinary locations that offer fixed pricing and require no coupon. These programs are referred to as SNAP EXPRESS.

As a SNAP EXPRESS client you pay a set price for the surgery. You may be required to pay the cost of pain medication for your pet's comfort, and mandatory low-cost vaccinations if your dog is not up-to-date on required shots. No additional office visit charge is applied to SNAP EXPRESS clients.

If you do not have email call 570-994-5846. The phone is only answered while volunteers are at Brodheadsville on days that clinic is open.

Cats: \$60 cash only for spay or neuter (fee includes rabies and distemper vaccines if needed)  
\$35 cash only Feral or free roaming cats (A feral/stray cat does not live in your house, includes rabies vaccine and left ear tip for identification-no exception.)

Dogs: please read "info prior to k9 surgery page".  
\$125 cash only for neuter - Male Dogs  
\$175 cash only for spay - Female Dogs  
(Vaccinations are extra, no vaccines given on day of surgery)  
Dogs that are overweight may be charged extra.

If you are scheduling more than one dog you will be asked to pay a non-refundable deposit. If you use pay pal there will be an extra \$5 fee. Your dog must have current distemper/rabies vaccine. If you need help with this please ask. Owners of dogs must be present unless other arrangements have been made prior to appointment.

Pre-operative in-house bloodwork -- \$40 highly recommended, not required for dogs and cats over 7 years of age.

Pre-operative bloodwork is available at Brodheadsville Clinic and Wilkes Barre Clinic. It is not available on the spaymobile.
